All pre-requisite course work for admission to the chiropractic program must be completed with a grade of 2.0 (“C”) or above on a 4.0 scale. In addition, the grade point average of the specific course requirements must average 2.5 or higher and the cumulative grade point average of all college courses must average 2.5 or higher. If the cumulative GPA averages below 2.5 then the average of the best 90 semester hours will be calculated.
