



LIFE UNIVERSITY MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

(Intended Admission to the Doctor of Chiropractic program; and a pathway for the student to transfer credits back to be awarded the Bachelor of Science with a major in Biology degree)

I. TITLE: Articulated Doctor of Chiropractic Agreement

II. TYPE OF AGREEMENT: Pre-requisite program for entrance into the Doctor of Chiropractic program at LIFE UNIVERSITY

III. PURPOSE: The purpose of the following articulated agreement is to facilitate the transfer of MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY students to the Doctor of Chiropractic program at LIFE UNIVERSITY, and via transferring of credits back to MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY to be able to be awarded the Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Biology by MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY.

V. COUNCIL ON CHIROPRACTIC EDUCATION ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Below are the present requirements for entrance into the Doctor of Chiropractic program. These requirements are established by the Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE), the accrediting agency for chiropractic. They may be changed or modified by the CCE. If they are modified, LIFE UNIVERSITY will notify MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY upon receipt of notification of the changes.

Prior to beginning a student's chiropractic education, they must have completed a minimum total of 90 semester credit hours or 135 quarter hours of non-duplicate coursework.

Of those overall hours completed, a minimum of 48 semester credit hours or 72 quarter credit hours must be credits in the coursework listed below, with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above.

Survey, or non-major courses, may not be accepted. Check with an Enrollment Specialist at 770-426-2884 or 800-543-3202.

In each of the distribution areas above, if more than one course is taken to fulfill the requirement, the course contents must be unduplicated.

In situations in which one or more courses have been repeated with equivalent courses, the most recent grade(s) may be used for grade point average computation and the earlier grade(s) may be disregarded.

Credits Earned via Examination: Applicants may earn a portion of the required/prerequisite credits through examination or means other than formal coursework, but only if these credits are identified by an institution accredited by a nationally recognized agency and if the institution has formally accepted or awarded such credits. Admission to the Doctor of Chiropractic educational program may be contingent upon receipt of such evidence of earned credits by the Admissions Department.

Alternative Admissions Track (AAT)

The AAT is for students who demonstrate the aptitude for success in the Doctor of Chiropractic Program (DCP), have a GPA between 2.75-2.99, and/or do not possess the minimum CCE criteria for regular admission.

The AAT is intended to provide an opportunity for students to enter the DCP who have either earned an undergraduate science or non-science degree with a GPA of 2.75-2.99, or for those who have completed 90 semester credit hours (135 quarter credit hours) with a 2.75-2.99 GPA. All science courses to be used for admission must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

All students will be considered by the College of Chiropractic Admissions Committee on an individual basis and accepted based on findings from the educational transcript evaluation. Final decision for DCP admission rests with the Dean of the College of Chiropractic.

VI. MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY CURRICULUM

Specific Education Course Requirements at Mount Vernon Nazarene University are included as an addendum to this agreement.

Any courses above not completed at Mount Vernon Nazarene University may be completed at Life University prior to admission to the chiropractic program.

VII. SPECIAL RELATIONSHIP CONDITIONS BETWEEN LIFE UNIVERSITY AND MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY

LIFE UNIVERSITY accepts credits from MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY'S Bachelor of Science, Major in Biology degree program towards LIFE UNIVERSITY'S Doctor of Chiropractic degree consistent with LIFE UNIVERSITY credit transfer policies.

MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY may accept classes taken at LIFE UNIVERSITY in the Doctor of Chiropractic degree program at the upper division level for transfer back in order for MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY to award the Bachelor of Science, Major in Biology degree.

VIII. PROVISIONS

A. ADMISSION

MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY: Current MOUNT VERSON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY policies apply. MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY retains sole responsibility for establishing the academic and other criteria that students must meet in order to fulfill its own entrance and graduation requirements and in evaluating student applications for admission.

LIFE UNIVERSITY: LIFE UNIVERSITY will admit to professional level status toward a chiropractic degree, students who complete the articulated pre-requisite requirements at MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY. LIFE UNIVERSITY retains sole responsibility for

establishing the academic and other criteria that students must meet in order to fulfill its own entrance and graduation requirements and in evaluating student applications for admission. Incoming students must meet all entry requirements for the Doctor of Chiropractic program. Acceptance into the chiropractic program does not guarantee successful completion of course requirements, leading to a degree of Doctor of Chiropractic.

LIFE UNIVERSITY will waive the application fee for MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY students applying to the chiropractic or pre-chiropractic program.

B. CATALOG IN EFFECT/CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT

LIFE UNIVERSITY: Students who complete the coursework under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their first registration must graduate within eight years of first admission to LIFE UNIVERSITY.

C. GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Refer to pages 1-2 of this document. Programs covered by this agreement shall be conducted under the direct supervision of the faculty and staff who provide the undergraduate and professional coursework, respectively.

The LIFE UNIVERSITY coordinator shall be the Dean of the College of Chiropractic. The LIFE UNIVERSITY coordinator shall be responsible for those program components that must be executed on the LIFE UNIVERSITY campus and shall communicate all appropriate matters directly with the MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY coordinator.

The MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY coordinator shall be the Dr. Paul Madtes Jr. or his designee. The MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY coordinator shall be responsible for the program components that must be executed on the MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY campus and shall communicate all appropriate matters directly with the LIFE UNIVERSITY coordinator.

D. GRADING POLICIES

LIFE UNIVERSITY: Graduation from the doctorate degree program at LIFE UNIVERSITY requires a minimum cumulative "C" (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) in LIFE UNIVERSITY coursework. Life University undergraduate programs currently utilize an "Average All" grade scheme involving repeated coursework.

LIFE UNIVERSITY: The LIFE UNIVERSITY Office of Admissions calculates GPAs for all transfer/entering students using the last grade earned. With regard to withdrawals and incompletes, the transcript information provided by the reporting institution is honored.

E. WAIVERS OR SUBSTITUTIONS

Any waiver or substitution of coursework at MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY must have prior approval by LIFE UNIVERSITY.

F. MINIMUM UPPER DIVISION HOURS

LIFE UNIVERSITY Doctor of Chiropractic admission requirements stipulate no semester hours of upper division coursework.

G. UPDATES AND TERMINATION

General: MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY'S performance under this Agreement and any amendments hereto or attachments connected herewith, shall at all times be subject to

any and all state laws, state regulations and Board of Trustee Rules which are applicable to the College's operations, commitments and/or activities in furtherance of any terms specified herein.

This agreement is subject to change by legislative action, the Department of Education, the LIFE UNIVERSITY Board of Trustees or the MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY Board of Trustees.

Update: This articulated curriculum agreement will be reviewed every year and shall be in effect from the date signed until any party identifies need for revision. The institution initiating the change will notify the other concerning any contemplated curricular changes that would affect the future of this agreement. Revisions will be made in writing and reviewed by the two respective Chief Academic Officers or their designees.

This articulation agreement will be reviewed and updated by MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY and the LIFE UNIVERSITY articulation officers.

Termination: Should this agreement be terminated, MOUNT VERNON NAZARENE UNIVERSITY students in the process of applying to LIFE UNIVERSITY at the time of cancellation will be allowed to complete the application process and complete degrees, subject to the requirement to complete the degree within eight years of the first LIFE UNIVERSITY course enrollment.

This agreement is effective only under the condition that both institutions maintain current accreditation by a regional accrediting association as recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. In the event either institution loses its accreditation, this agreement will immediately terminate.

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Any variation in this program may result in additional required coursework.

I. LENGTH OF AGREEMENT

This articulation agreement shall be in effect from its date of signing until termination by either party upon ninety (90) days' notice to the other party in writing. This agreement may be modified or amended by mutual consent by the two participating institution Presidents or their specified designees in writing.
