1. **An application** for the program you desire to attend. Online application is located here:

2. **Non-refundable \$50 application processing fee**
3. **All official international transcripts:** (High School and University) must be **translated and evaluated** via one of these approved agencies with NACES at <https://www.naces.org/members>
  - LIFE University has an agreement with the Foundation for International Services (FIS) <https://www.fis-web.com/credential-evaluations/> evaluation company. You will get considerable discount for the evaluation services and faster and convenient service (maximum 2 weeks) if you th FIS-LIFE U application. Please ask us about the form.
4. **Test score for English language proficiency:**
  - [TOEFL](#) (Test of English as a Foreign Language) (scores 500 or higher, 173 or higher on the computer-based, or the Internet-based TOEFL- 61 or higher)
  - [IELTS](#) (International English Language Testing System), A minimum score of 5.5 on the IELTS
  - Duolingo English Proficiency. A minimum score of 85-90 on the Duolingo is required. <https://englishtest.duolingo.com/>

*\*\*Applicants from some countries are exempt from the English language proficiency exam, please see the relevant attachment.*

If you do not have 24 or more transferable credit hours to LIFE University, please submit scores for one of the following tests: SCHOLASTIC APTITUDE TEST (SAT) OR AMERICAN COLLEGE TEST (ACT)

### **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN FORM I-20**

All international applicants who need an F-1 visa must apply for the *I-20 Certificate of Eligibility*. You can submit the following documents after your acceptance at LIFE University.

**1) I-20 Request Form.** Complete and submit I20 Request Form after your acceptance at LIFE.

**2) Bank letter.** U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) requires international students to show the University evidence of adequate financial resources to provide for at least one year of full-time educational and living expenses as estimated below.

**3) Sponsor Letter:** With your I-20 request form, you must submit the **Sponsor Letter** (please see the form). You must provide a recent financial statement (no earlier than six months before matriculation), translated into US Dollars, from a bank or financial institution.

**4) Mandatory health insurance policy** that meets the following minimum requirements: Deductible: \$500 or less; Medical Benefits: Minimum \$50,000-\$100,000; Medical Evacuation: \$25,000-\$50,000. \*\*
